



**Attention: All Pike Electric, Inc. Medical Plan Participants**

**Something's changing. It will save you money. It's easy. Here's how.**

**What's changing?**

If you are currently filling your maintenance medications every 30 days, effective November 1, 2010, you will be required to fill them for a 90-day supply instead of 30. For any new maintenance medications you fill after this date, you will be able to fill them 3 times, and after the 3<sup>rd</sup> fill you will be required to fill them for a 90-day supply, instead of 30. This will help you and Pike save money on your prescriptions.

Example: for generic medications, instead of paying 3 copays of \$15 (a total of \$45) for a 90-day supply, you will now only pay \$30 for a 90-day supply – saving you \$15. It's that easy to save.

**What do I need to do?**

If your prescription for maintenance medications is currently written for only 30 days, and you are at a Walgreens pharmacy, ask the pharmacist to assist you with the mandatory 90-day fill. If you are unable to visit a Walgreens pharmacy, you may call Walgreens Customer Service at 866-287-4177 and they will assist you with locating a Walgreens pharmacy, or register you over the phone for mail-service. You may also call the Pike Benefits Department at 866-621-2504 for further assistance.

To find out if your prescription is considered maintenance or not, call Walgreens Customer Service at 866-287-4177, or you may ask your pharmacist to check for you.

**How does this affect me?**

You will pay only 2 copays for a 90-day supply of maintenance medication. You'll be saving 1 copay every 90 days. It's that easy.
